On 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2022, the ISS organized a Workshop for the RC Conveners in which distinguished past Presidents - Prof. Anand Kumar and Prof. R. Indira and Secretary, Prof. Rajesh Misra were the Resource Persons. The Workshop deliberated upon important issues pertaining to the RCs. I have always emphasized on bringing out good publications by the RCs as well as the ISS, and I hope we will be able to achieve some success in this direction.

The Managing Committee meeting of the ISS was held on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi in which some routine matters were discussed as well as important decisions were taken. I also thank the outgoing team of office bearers for conducting ISS activities, especially the Mumbai All India Sociological Conference (AISC), in a most professional manner, despite the wrath of Corona pandemic.

The new team of office bearers comprising the President, Secretary, Treasurer, and five new, and, ten members elected to the Managing Committee between 2018 and 2021, took charge of the office in January 2022 for taking the ISS activities forward. Some of the main challenges and tasks before the newly appointed office bearers are, to name a few, streamlining the ISS activities; strengthening and rationalizing Research Committees (RCs) and making them more vibrant; encouraging RCs to publish their respective e-journals apart from bringing out peer-reviewed editorial volumes from reputed national/international publishers, based on the papers presented in annual conferences of ISS or other RC events; organizing/helping RCs to conduct lectures on emergent research issues; and,

strengthening the methodological proficiency of researchers, students, and younger faculty of Sociology.

We also look forward to organizing ISS events in the offline and hybrid mode and supporting Regional Associations to build their membership base, and work in close collaboration with ISS. We hope to complete the work of updating the ISS Membership Directory, and request members to share their membership details, if it is still to be done.

We have already conducted meetings of the Managing Committee (12<sup>th</sup> March 2022). Conveners of the Research Committees (2<sup>nd</sup> April 2022), and organized a Workshop for RC Conveners on April 23 in which an interaction was organized with two former Presidents of ISS, Prof. Anand Kumar and Prof. R. Indira, and former Secretary Prof. Rajesh Mishra. Meetings with Editors of ISS Journals and representatives of Sage Publications have also been organized. In the meeting with Sage representatives, it was decided that henceforth ISS would send the link to the journal Sociological Bulletin (SB) to email IDs of Life Members to ensure easy access. I am happy to bring to your notice that this has already been done. Sage has agreed to freeze the price of the physical copies of SB to the last year's cost for the next two years. Many sub-committees of the MC have been constituted to oversee the functioning of different tasks that we have set ahead for the ISS.

The ISS is extending support to RCs to conduct Research Methodology/Academic Writing Workshops, as per the Guidelines set apart for allocation of resources. I am happy to share with you that RC 28 has been granted this facility for organizing a workshop on "Methodological Significance of Social Science Theories" at North Bengal University. I request all RCs to come up with proposals for organizing workshops in future months.

We have some more challenging tasks ahead. Most important among these is the organization of the All-India Sociological Congress (AISC) in December 2022. We are still looking forward to receiving proposals from universities conducting this year's AISC. I take this opportunity to request all those interested to send proposals for holding the AISC in their universities, duly routed through their respective Vice-chancellors. Moreover, we have to further expand our membership base by adding more and more young research scholars and teachers. Therefore, I request all the esteemed members to encourage their research scholars and colleagues to take membership of ISS. To revise and update the ISS membership directory, we have already circulated google forms on various social media platforms with a request to fill it up by providing your details. I will use this medium to request you all once again, to kindly fill-up the form, if you have not done it so far. We also wish to strengthen our regional associations and encourage them to be proactive in carrying on sociological activities in their respective states by coordinating with ISS more intensively. Such states which do not yet have regional associations at present are also requested to think about it seriously and initiate steps to form their regional associations.

To conclude, I thank all the MC members, RC Conveners, and other office staff of ISS for their tireless efforts in making the ISS mission a concrete reality.

# FIRST ISS MANAGING COMMITTEE MEETING IN 2022

The first ISS Managing Committee Meeting was held on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2022 at CSSS, JNU, New Delhi. Prof. Vivek Kumar, Chairperson of CSSS hosted the meeting and provided a warm local hospitality to all the ISS officials and MC members. The meeting began with the Welcome Address by the President of ISS, Prof. Abha Chauhan followed by the introduction of the members present. The President informed that the newly elected office-bearers of ISS formally took over the charge from the outgoing office bearers on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022 in which Prof. Abha Chauhan (President-elect) and Prof. Manish K. Verma (Secretary elect) were physically present in the office whereas the outgoing office bearers Prof. Paramjit Singh Judge (outgoing President), Prof. Jagan Karade (outgoing Secretary) and Prof. Satish Sharma (outgoing Treasurer) were available online. Further, she informed the MC regarding the nomination of Prof. Shruti Tambe as the new Treasurer of ISS. She enumerated the efforts of the newly elected office bearers

within the past two months by informing the house about the meeting held with Sage and the past and present editors of ISS journals. Reports regarding the 46<sup>th</sup> All India Sociological Conference held (online) in Mumbai in December 2021 and of the Editors of ISS Journals were presented. Some important



decisions were taken during the meeting, one of them being the enhancement and fixing of the fees to be paid by the Regional Association. The MC also appointed Dr. Sanjay Nilkanth Kolekar (Pune) as the Adhoc Convener for RC-22. Besides these, various Committees were formed for the smooth functioning of the ISS.

#### **Committees Formed**

Affiliation fees of the Regional Associations: In the last MC meeting, it was decided to enhance the fees of the Regional Association to Rs.1, 000/-(One Thousand Only) with effect from April 2022 to affiliate with ISS.

# **Regional Associations**

The formation of Regional Associations in different states, where it does not exist yet, was stressed by President Prof. Abha Chauhan during the MC Meeting. Further, it is viewed that strong academic collaborations/linkages should be explored between ISS and various Regional Associations. Prof. Ajailiu Niumai appraised the house about the formation of the North East India Sociological Association and its future plans. The Regional Association has to register itself with ISS by paying a requisite fee. The MC decided to enhance the RC registration fee to Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand Only). Earlier it was Rs. 600/- (Six Hundred Only).

The Treasurer Prof. Shruti Tambe presented the financial report and it was suggested that the Membership Fees should be increased as below:

The MC agreed to implement the revised rates from next year (January 2023) onwards for items listed at SI. No. 1, 2 & 3 and April 2022 for SI. No. 4. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by ISS Secretary Prof. Manish K. Verma.

#### RC CONVENER'S MEETING

The RC Conveners held their 1<sup>st</sup> Meeting for the year 2022 on the 2nd of April. The meeting was chaired by Prof. Abha Chauhan, President, ISS. She welcomed all the old and new RC Conveners and MC members who had also joined the meeting. In her Address, she emphasized the activities and publications to undertaken by the RCs. Prof. Arvinder Ansari, the Convener of the Committee coordinate the activities of RCs presented her report. It



was decided that Prof. Ansari would prepare the report regarding the RC Rules to be discussed and finalized in the next RC Conveners' meeting. During the meeting, some MC members expressed their viewpoints to strengthen the RCs. The RC Conveners presented reports of their RCs and shared their proposed activities for the future. The Treasurer, Prof Shruti Tambe gave her input on the financial aspects. The house also reviewed matters pertaining to the RC rules of 2017 and later amendments, and an online training program/workshop of RC Conveners was proposed to be organized. Other matters such as RC membership, RC publications, mid-term seminars/webinars and workshops, and the like were also discussed. It ended with a vote of thanks by the ISS Secretary, Prof. Manish K. Verma.

#### RC CONVENER'S WORKSHOP

On 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2022, ISS organised the RC Convener's Workshop online. The President of ISS, Prof. Abha

Chauhan chaired the Workshop and delivered opening remarks. The Conveners of RCs and MC members commented on various aspects pertaining to each RC in general and ISS in particular. The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks by ISS Secretary Prof. Manish K. Verma. The three resource persons viz; Prof. Anand Kumar, Prof. R. Indira, and Prof. Rajesh Misra delivered lucid and invaluable invited talks for the RC Conveners and ISS officials. Prof. Anand Kumar and Prof. R. Indira are past Presidents and Prof. Rajesh Misra has been the past Secretary of ISS. They shared their experiences and suggested ideas to strengthen the ISS.



Prof. Anand Kumar was of the view that RC Conveners must possess academic credentials and knowledge in their particular domain. He put forward the idea for RCs to have a Convener, Co-Convener, and Treasurer to nurture new leadership. In bigger RCs, two Co-conveners may be appointed to assist the Convener. With regard to the RC newsletter, he recommended that RC Convener must be the editor, and Co-convener contribute as co-editor. He expressed that online newsletters may be published and multilingual abstracts/papers to be accepted in RCs. He also suggested that RCs be connected digitally on



various platforms such as WhatsApp groups and their activities be closely knitted with the ISS. He pointed out that RCs must seek guidance and services from the seniors, particularly to facilitate as Chairperson, Discussant, and the like during AISC and mid-term seminars/workshops/conferences. He emphasised that mid-term seminars/conferences may be organised often but professional ethics and quality must be maintained. He also advocated for multilingualism with the aim that Indian languages can be nurtured by RCs, and thus RCs must invite papers in regional languages. Finally, he emphasized that since the stalwarts of the last generation have worked hard to strengthen Sociology as one of the youngest disciplines in Social Sciences through ISS, therefore, everyone must continue to work with vigor and enthusiasm for ISS.

Prof. R. Indira mentioned that RC Conveners may attempt to explore collaboration with colleges and state universities across the country. There are institutions that are keen to collaborate with ISS. She said that each RC has 70% of registration fees from the ISS and the Conveners this fund to may use organize workshops/seminars/conferences. There must be inter-RCs collaborations and mixed themes in these days of multidisciplinary approach and intersectionality research. We have been mandated to engage in collaborations these days and hence, RCs must think of working together and must engage in listening, learning, and unlearning, she said. Prof. Indira further elaborated that more than two RCs could take the initiative of organizing academic writing workshops. This will de-centralize responsibility and take ISS forward. She also suggested

that each RC must conduct a Business Meeting quarterly and invite the President and Secretary of ISS in which RC Conveners can share their experiences and challenges and seek input to improve the RCs.

Prof. Rajesh Misra emphasized in his presentation that RCs should work as a research network in their field of specialisation for encouragement and help the younger professionals to train them. There is also a need to involve senior Professors to handle and train the younger generation. According to him, RCs

should be a platform where younger, senior, and middle-level professionals meet. He emphasised that RCs have to focus on the following:

- a. Need to stop regional parochialism. It is affecting the research standards in all Institutions.
- b. Bureaucratisation of academic activities must reduce. We need rules and regulations that balance bureaucratisation and academic autonomy or professional independence.
- c. Decentralisation of academic activities in an intellectual way is a must in RC'S.
- d. Involve senior Professors to assess the RC papers to improve the quality of sessions.
- e. There must be financial regulations to strengthen the RC'S.
