THE THEME

'Sociology In Regions' and 'Sociology Of Regions' are two approaches that seek to understand the social and cultural characteristics of a specific spatial and ecological region. The founder of Lucknow School of Sociology, Professor Radha Kamal Mukerjee highlighted the importance of understanding the historical and cultural forces that shape the region's development and the experiences of its people thereby giving rise to what can be called as 'Regional Sociology'. He believed that regional sociology should not be limited to the study of social and economic structures but should also take into account the region's environmental, historical and cultural factors. This holistic approach would help us to understand the complex relationship between society and the environment and how this relationship shapes the region's development and the origin and growth of the discipline of Sociology in a particular region.

In the context of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 too, region as a category has been emphasized. It recognizes the importance of regional diversity and aims at promoting multilingualism and the preservation of local cultures and languages. Further, the policy emphasizes the need to integrate local knowledge systems and cultural practices into the education system and to provide opportunities for students to learn about the history and traditions of their region. The theme of the conference is aptly in consonance with the objectives of NEP and aims at deliberating on the grounded practices, specific needs and challenges faced in/of different regions and articulate the possibility of an inclusive society.

Keeping in view of the idea of our founder Prof. Radha Kamal Mukerjee and the National Education Policy, the department of sociology is celebrating its centenary year by organizing this conference. It has the following themes for the plenary and technical sessions:

1. Region, Culture and Identities

2. Citizenship and Ethnicity

3. Ecology, Economy and Sustainability

4. 100 Years of Sociology at the University of Lucknow
Besides Inaugural and Valedictory sessions, there will be two sessions each of 28 research
committees and 01 Adhoc Group (parallel sessions).

विशिष्ट स्थानीय और पारिस्थितिक क्षेत्रों की सामाजिक और सांस्कृतिक विशेषताओं को समझने के लिए 'क्षेत्रों में समाजशास्त्र' और 'क्षेत्रों का समाजशास्त्र', दो दृष्टिकोण हैं समाजशास्त्र के लखनऊ संप्रदाय के संस्थापक प्रोo राधा कमल मुखर्जी ने उन ऐतिहासिक और सांस्कृतिक शक्तिओं को समझने की महत्ता पर बल दिया जो क्षेत्रों के विकास और इसके लोगों के अनुभवों को आकार देते हैं, और इसलिए उन्होंने 'क्षेत्रीय समाजशास्त्र' के उदय पर बल दिया। उनका विश्वास था कि समाजशास्त्र सामाजिक और आर्थिक संरचनाओं के अध्ययन मात्र से ही संबंधित नहीं होना चाहिए बल्कि क्षेत्र के पर्यावरणीय, ऐतिहासिक और सांस्कृतिक कारकों को भी संज्ञान में लेना चाहिए। यह समग्र दृष्टिकोण हमें न केवल समाज और पर्यावरण के मध्य जटिल संबंधों को समझने में मदद करेगा, बल्कि यह भी स्पष्ट करेगा कि यह संबंध किस प्रकार क्षेत्र के विकास और किसी विशिष्ट क्षेत्र में समाजशास्त्र विषय की वृद्धि को आकार देता है।

नई शिक्षा नीति 2020 के संदर्भ में भी क्षेत्र को एक विशेष श्रेणी के रूप में बल दिया गया है। यह क्षेत्रीय विविधताओं और बहुभाषावाद को बढ़ावा देने तथा स्थानीय संस्कृतियों और भाषाओं को संरक्षण देने की महत्ता को संज्ञान में लेता है। इसके अतिरिक्त यह नीति शैक्षणिक व्यवस्था, स्थानीय ज्ञान व्यवस्था और सांस्कृतिक व्यवहारों को एकीकृत करने की आवश्यकता पर बल देती है, साथ ही छात्रों को अपने क्षेत्रीय इतिहास एवं परपंराओं को भी समझने के लिए प्रोत्साहित करती है। सम्मेलन का विषय निश्चय ही नई शिक्षा नीति के उद्देश्यों के अनुरूप है। इसका लक्ष्य विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में / के अन्दर पाये जाने वाले धरातलीय चलनों, विशिष्ट आवश्यकताओं और चुनौतियों को अभिव्यक्त करना है, साथ ही एक समावेशी समाज की आवश्यकताओं को स्पष्ट करना है।

समाजशास्त्र विभाग के प्रतिष्ठाता प्रो. राधा कमल मुखर्जी एवं राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति के विचारों के सन्दर्भ में यह सम्मेलन शताब्दी वर्ष के उपलक्ष्य में आयोजित किया जा रहा है। यह सम्मेलन विभिन्न विशिष्ट एवं तकनीक सत्रों के लिए निम्नलिखित मुददों को प्रस्तुत करता है —
